Job and Boat list

Sort out kayak and paddle board store with additional brackets to support kayaks

Check kayaks and paddle for working equipment along identifications and the marking

Boat yard gates need adjustment along with TLC

Cut up any scrap ready for collection

Grease all working locks

Generally, tidy up

Install dragons teeth, tidy back into Alley well, opposite boat yard gates

Re-varnish tables and benches on the beach

Generally clear stones to drop off below concrete plinth (mulberry stone), quite dangerous at the moment

Fix concrete plinth around winch to help locking up and safety standing. Fix back metal frame work for easy locking

Tidy Sail loft to leave ready for meeting use

Tidy up side alley of club to allow for new shed to store kids game for easy access

Still out-standing items:

Lighting to side walkway

Repair framing to stairs entering the club,

Construct new stone above the stairs
