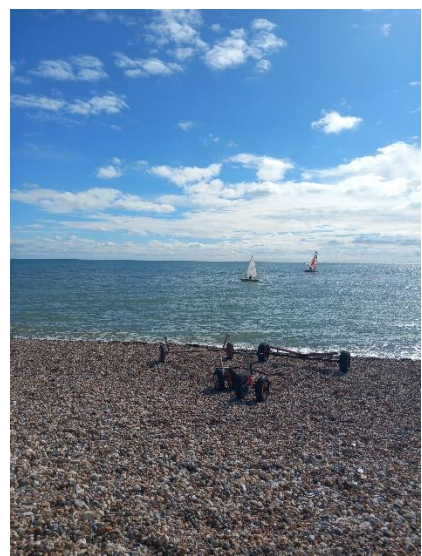
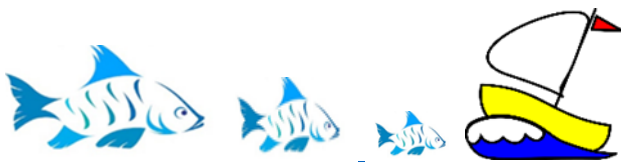


Hi Everybody,

Future Entertainment

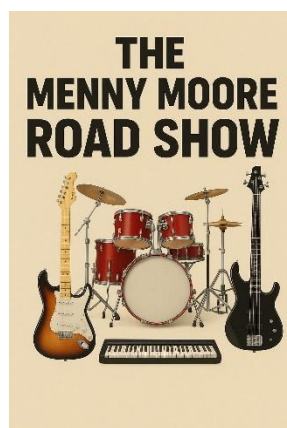
What a weekend we have to look forward to...
