The next Angling meeting will be held on Wednesday 12th November, lots to discuss!

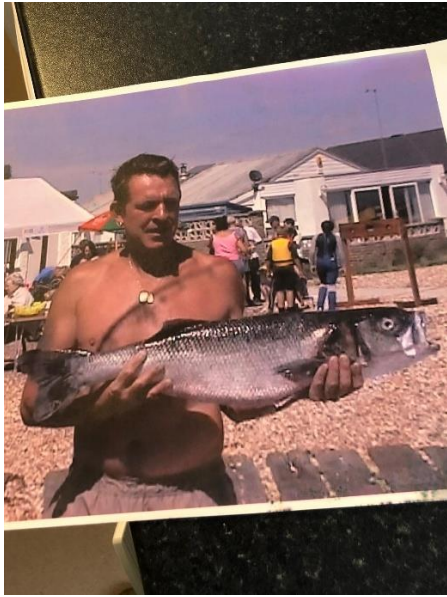
I have no reports of any fishing from last week hopefully some have a go this week!

So far so good with the new addition to our beers on tap, with Hazy Days far out selling Doombar, the product we replaced. At this pace it will start to be our lead selling beer. Our newly created Bar team (three months ago), include real ale drinkers and they have added ideas into the mix regarding bringing on a “hand pumped” ale. We are investigating this with the brewery, so watch this space.

New spirits are in place with Kraken rum replacing Mount Gay, and a new selection of bottled beers replacing Fullers London Pride. Let the team know what you think of the new beer selection as not all will remain, just the bestselling ones. When they are gone, they are gone, so drink up and report back, so we can start to stock your choice asap. Pink Prosecco is also back in stock, and new lines for the children, with “Smoothies” and “Yo Yo Bear” snacks added.

New glasses, trays, optics, storage areas, umbrellas for outside (maybe not for use this year again) a tidy up behind the bar to give us more room. New beer mat holders, new bulbs in the fridges and new lighting all around the bar area including the “Snug”. A storage bracket for the “play your cards right” board, making it safer for you to hang up your coats. Now the evenings are closing in, it will be a little better to see what you are drinking and to hang up your coats safely.

New hand dryers have been installed in the toilets a while back, even though the gents one is broken and awaiting an engineer to attend.

The cellar has been revamped creating more space for stock, allowing us to see that is needed each week when we do the brewery, Sainsbury’s, Tesco, Iceland and Bar Supplies orders, and it is now halfway through being re decorated.

We are still looking for volunteers to serve behind the bar; full training will be given including how to use the till. We are also putting together video’s on how to change

barrels, glass washer use, opening the bar and closing it. If you would like to find out more please ask for Phill Young or David Gosnell and we will explain what is required, as well as putting together a training plan. Your first few sessions will be “escorted” with a fully trained club member, so you will not be on your own. Just one hour a week will allow us to keep the bar open and stop Phill having to chase people to fill in the gaps in the rota.

Finally, the bar volunteers and management team would like to thank Theresa Woolven (our cleaner) for her Stirling work keeping behind the bar clean, as it can become a mess on busy days, and especially removing the “sticky” floor after each session.
