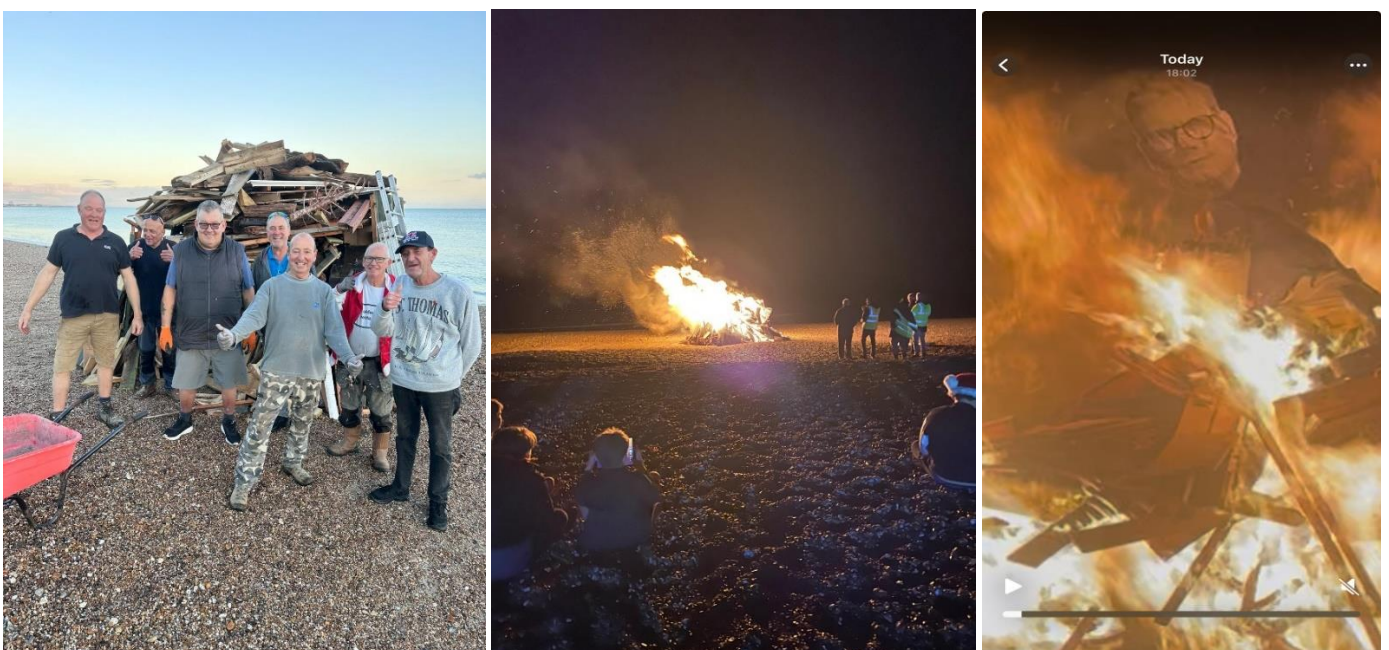
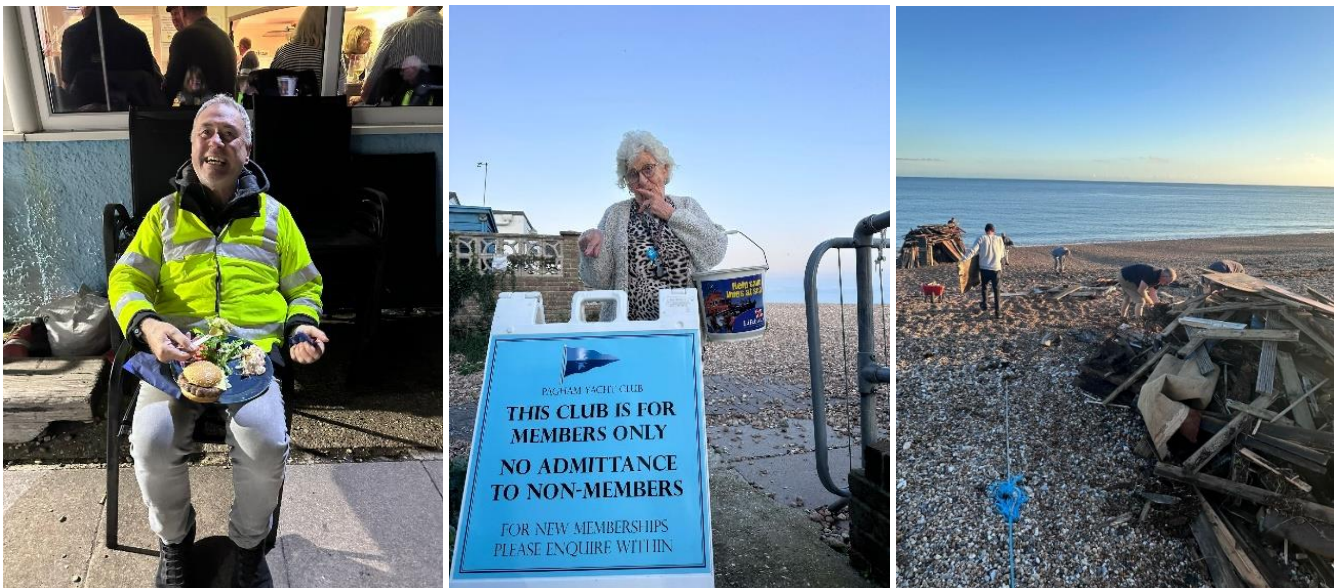
Fireworks Party
