Dinner Dance

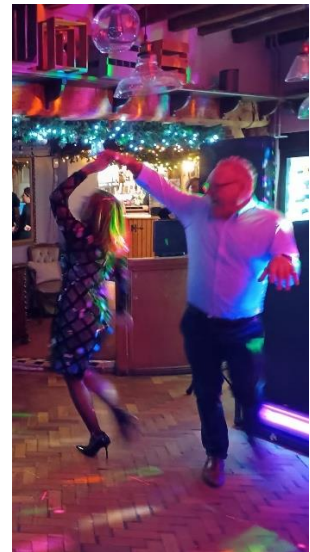
Oh, What a Night!
