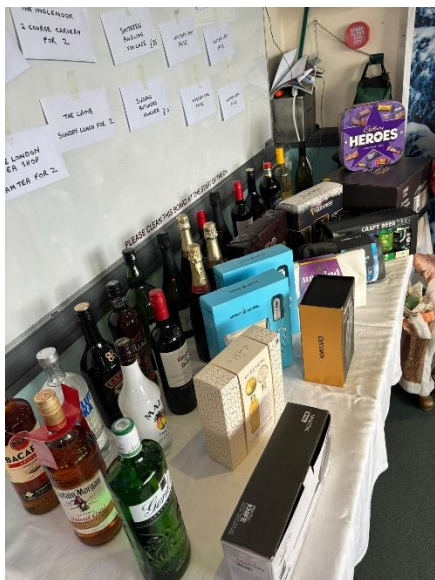


Christmas Raffle
